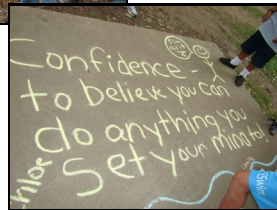


LEADERSHIP LA PORTE COUNTY YOUTH
